

Hakodate has a multitude of tourism resources, including the stunning night view from Mt. Hakodate, which the city boasts to the world, an exotic cityscape incorporating Western culture, and a food culture nurtured by the richly blessed sea. The opening of the Hokkaido Shinkansen line has improved access to the city in recent years, and it is increasingly attracting attention. The venue of many large-scale conventions is also centered on Hakodate Arena, further enhancing the MICE environment.

Hakodate Arena

This is the core facility for MICE activities in Hakodate. With excellent access, it comprises a main arena accommodating up to 5,000 people, a sub arena, conference rooms for large and small sectional meetings, as well as spaces for exhibitions and other events. In addition to large-scale conventions, various sports competitions and concerts can also be arranged.

Hakodate Citizen Hall

A multipurpose facility adjacent to Hakodate Arena. In addition to a spacious large hall with a capacity of 1,370 seats, there is also a small hall with a maximum capacity of 500 people, a large conference room (up to 300 seats), and small conference rooms (up to 30 people each). Large-scale conventions can also be hosted jointly at Hakodate Citizen Hall and Hakodate Arena.

Special Historic Goryokaku Site and Goryokaku Tower

Goryokaku is a star-shaped fort built on the spot where the Battle of Hakodate was fought. It is a famous cherry blossom-viewing spot in spring, and serves as a park where citizens can relax. The adjacent Goryokaku Tower is 107 m high and offers a bird's-eye view of the star-shaped Goryokaku Site, providing a unique venue with a park.

(World Heritage) Jomon Prehistoric Sites in Northern Japan Kakinoshima and Ofune Sites


The Jomon Prehistoric Sites in Northern Japan were registered as a World Cultural Heritage Site in 2021. The Activities & Kakinoshima and Ofune Sites are within Hakodate. At the attractions Kakinoshima Site visitors can see pit dwellings, the largest earthwork mound in Japan, as well as objects bearing witness to the transformation of spiritual culture at the time. At the Ofune Site, the remains of nearly 100 pit dwellings, including large ones can be viewed. Guides are available to provide

Mt. Hakodate Ropeway enables visitors to enjoy the beautiful cityscape and night view of Hakodate. The mountaintop observatory is equipped with restaurants where receptions with spectacular views can be held. as well as an event hall with a capacity of approximately 160 people where presentations and lectures can be held.

Nanae, which is adjacent to Hakodate, is a town of various aspects blessed with a mild climate and magnificent nature. Mt. Komagatake and Onuma Quasi-national Park offer beautiful seasonal scenery. The town also has the features of a resort area, with leisure activities such as sightseeing boats and nature walks, sports such as golf, tennis and skiing, and a variety of seasonal events, making it ideal for unique venues and activities.



Guided Onuma Park Nature Walk

There are three lakes that are all dotted with smaller and larger islands. Some islands are connected by bridges and some have footpaths, creating a net-like image. Among these paths are five special trails highlighting different spots of interest such as swamps, Mt. Komagatake, and various kinds of flora and fauna. Guides are available to lead visitors along these paths.

Hakodate Nanae Gondola Aerial walk and nature experience in a gondola

The Hakodate Nanae Gondola, which climbs 3,319 m, takes visitors on a 30-minute round-trip aerial walk providing a spectacular view from the mountaintop. From the gondola's windows, visitors can watch the magnificent scenery of Mt. Komagatake and Onuma Quasi-National Park unfold, while the mountaintop offers a boardwalk with observatory decks. If the timing is right, a fantastic sea of clouds may also be seen.



Surrounded by Mt. Yotei, also known as "Ezo Fuji," and Niseko Annupuri, the main peak of the Niseko mountain range, Kutchan is a town where tourism and agriculture are thriving. Also known as a ski sanctuary called "Saint Moritz of the East," the entire region is visited by tourists from all over the world for long-term stays. Accordingly, know-how on serving foreign visitors has been accumulated, and accommodation facilities and restaurants offer excellent services. In summer, comfortable meetings can be held in a refreshing climate and various activities can be enjoyed.





Ski resorts

The ski resorts of Kutchan and Niseko are commendable for their magnificent scenery, excellent snow quality, and heavy snowfall. Powder snow accumulates on the plain between the Niseko mountain range and Mt. Yotei, while a high volume of snowfall of moderate humidity due to the location near the Sea of Japan, sustain these world-class snow resorts.

Due to the large number of long-stay visitors, there are many condominiums with spacious floor plans in the town, where it is possible to hold small meetings and parties while enjoying the beautiful scenery.





SOMOZA

Opened in 2017 by creative director Shouya Grigg, SOMOZA is a complex facility that integrates a gallery, shop, and restaurant in an old private house relocated from Tochigi Prefecture. Exhibitions and workshops can be held in a space radiating the appeal of culture, tradition, and nature of Hokkaido and Japan.







Rafting

The Shiribetsu River, which flows through Kutchan and Niseko, is one of the clearest rivers in Japan and carries a large volume of water, making it an ideal field for playing in the river. Rafting is the most popular activity, providing a thrilling experience in the torrent of the thawing season. Summer allows slow and fun rafting. Professional guide companies offer numerous tours.





Potatoes

Potato flowers blooming all over the ground are a summer feature of Kutchan. The most frequently found variety is "Danshaku," and high-quality potatoes are grown due to the large temperature difference between day and night. On some farms in the town, you can experience farm work such as digging up potatoes.

Japanese sake Niseko

Niseko Shuzo, which was established in 1916, is a sake brewery where the focus is on "high-quality water, air and environment as well as undiluted sake that is not adjusted for alcohol content by adding water." Snowmelt from the Niseko Weiss Mountains and spring water from Mt. Yotei are used in the production process. A local sake made from Hokkaido rice also serves as a popular gift.

The town name "Niseko" is said to have originated from the Ainu language words "nisey-ko-an," meaning "cliff, heading, river." In this town one can enjoy wonderful natural scenery, including Mt. Yotei and the Niseko mountain range, various activities, and an appeal that changes with the four seasons. In 2013, Niseko Town was selected by the Japanese Government as an "environmental model city" where pioneering efforts are made to realize a low-carbon society. It was also selected as an "SDGs future city" in 2018 based on the local government's efforts to achieve the sustainable development goals.







Goshiki Onsenkyo

Hot springs in Niseko include Goshiki Onsen, Konbu Onsen, and Annupuri Onsen, with their different qualities and color of the water - such as transparent, milky white, and brown. The "Niseko Hot Spring Pass," a discount ticket, allows you to enjoy the various hot spring facilities scattered around the area at a discount price. The pass is available at Michi-no-Eki Niseko View Plaza and other places.





Arishima Takeo Memorial Museum

Takeo Arishima is a novelist who wrote The Descendants of Cain, Chiisaki Monohe (To the Little Ones), and The Agony of Coming into the World. In 1992, he opened his privately owned Arishima Farm in Niseko free of charge based on the idea of "mutual aid." The Memorial Museum, which was built on the farm in 1978, includes a permanent exhibition room where Takeo's life and ideas are introduced, and various special exhibitions are held here. It is a place where one can experience local literature and art.

Hilton Niseko Village

Hilton Niseko Village, one of Japan's foremost resort hotels located at the foot of Niseko Annupuri, has much experience hosting MICE events with a perfect support system. The main hall is a large space with a 13-floor-high atrium that can accommodate 900 people.











Niseko Central Warehouse Group

This is a group of facilities erected in renovated warehouses and an old starch factory exemplifying the history of the region that are used by many people as various event venues and coworking spaces.

Michi-no-Eki Niseko View Plaza

Located at the intersection of National Highway 5 and Prefectural Road 66 as the gateway to the Niseko area, it has a tourist information center, farmers' market, and food court. 



In Sapporo, the capital of Hokkaido with a population of approximately 1.97 million, efforts have always been made to develop creative content while taking advantage of its perfect combination of magnificent nature and urban convenience. As a legacy of the G8 Hokkaido Toyako Summit of 2008, the city launched Japan's first MICE Service System that promotes environmentally friendly practices at MICE events. In 2015, the city was guick to use the Global Destination Sustainability Index (GDS-Index) to measure its sustainability performance as a tourism destination. Vigorous efforts have been under way to make Sapporo a sustainable destination. Sapporo has been chosen by numerous organizers as an international MICE destination where new value and connections are created thanks to its easy accessibility from across Japan and elsewhere, various unique venues, and popularity as a tourist destination.

Okurayama Ski Jump Stadium

Sapporo is an advanced city where numerous international sports competitions have been held throughout the year since it staged Asia's first Winter Olympics in 1972. The Okurayama Ski Jump Stadium served as a venue of the Winter Olympics and presently also houses the Sapporo Olympic Museum on its premises. The stadium hosts many international competitions, and popular MICE programs offered there include ski jumping competitions in summer.



Moerenuma Park

Designed by the world-renowned sculptor Isamu Noguchi. Moerenuma Park was developed as a 188.8-hectare urban park by greening a landfill site. It has gained attention both in Japan and abroad for its environmental initiatives. including a snow-powered cooling system introduced at the iconic

Glass Pyramid. The restaurant on the first floor of the pyramid, L'enfant Qui Reve, has served as the venue of banquets for U.N. and international governmental conferences.







Sapporo Beer Garden

Sapporo Beer Garden is popular for its fresh draft beer and Genghis Khan lamb barbecue, a specialty in Hokkaido, not only among locals but also among tourists from across Japan and elsewhere. Facilities include the red-brick Kaitakushi-kan building with its iconic chimney and Poplar House, which can accommodate up to 500 people on each floor.

Sapporo Art Park

The Sapporo Art Park was developed with the aim of creating a new forum of arts and culture for the North. Located in the suburbs of Sapporo, the park supports various aspects of arts and culture, including fine arts, crafts, and music. It also serves as a venue for the Pacific Music Festival (PMF), known as one of the world's three largest educational music festivals, and for the Sapporo City Jazz festival. The park has a facility where closed-door banquets can be held. The outdoor museum there, known as the Sculpture Garden, is the perfect place for various activities, including snowshoe walking in winter.

Otaru and Yoichi

A port city interwoven with industrial history and a town known as Hokkaido's preeminent fruit kingdom

AREA 06

As the commercial capital of Hokkaido, Otaru supported the economy of Hokkaido in pre-war years. It thrived as herring fishery prospered and hosted kitamae-bune merchant ships, which laid the foundation for development, following a path of prosperity as the cornerstone of distribution in Hokkaido—distribution which forms part of an industrial modernization story connecting coal mines in the Sorachi region, ironworks and steel mills in Muroran, and the port of Otaru (known as Tan-Tetsu-Ko (Coal, Steel, Railways, and Ports) on the Japan Heritage List). Otaru was booming to such an extent that novelist Takiji Kobayashi once wrote, "Otaru is like the heart of Hokkaido." The Ironai area, where branch offices of the Bank of Japan and other financial institutions as well as trading companies (Mitsui & Co. and Mitsubishi Corporation) were located, has buildings that convey the history of the city's development. Some of the buildings are available as unique venues. After a drive of approximately 25 minutes from Otaru one reaches Yoichi Town. Agriculture, particularly fruit cultivation, and fishing are key industries in this town where efforts are also made to promote wine tourism.

Otaru Canal

The Otaru Canal, a symbol of prosperity of the city, emerged from a reclamation crisis and has become a must-visit scenic spot today. Along the canal, facilities perfectly suited for MICE events, including hotels overlooking the canal and restaurants repurposed from old warehouses, are located. The canal also offers opportunities for outdoor activities, including 40-minute-long cruising trips.

Ironai Bank Street

Ironai Bank Street was home to branches of major financial institutions and trading companies in Hokkaido and elsewhere, and those buildings created a fascinating sight. The Bank of Japan Otaru Branch building was designed by Dr. Kingo Tatsuno, the well-known architect of the red-brick Tokyo Station, and his pupil, and now serves as the Bank of Japan Otaru Museum. The Former Mitsui Bank Otaru Branch, popular for its Renaissance-style building with stone arches, is among buildings forming the Otaru Art Base and is available for MICE banquets.





Unique

Kitamae-bune merchant ships (Japan Heritage)

Otaru was among the ports where kitamae-bune merchant ships connecting Hokkaido with the Tohoku and Hokuriku regions on mainland Japan called. The Former Kitahama District Warehouses, built in the 20s and 30s of the Meiji era (around the end of the 19th century), convey the history of those merchant ships. Among the former warehouses, the Former Otaru Warehouse houses Otaru Museum Annex (known today as the Otaru Museum of History and Nature) and the Canal Plaza (Otaru International Information Center), and the Former Shibusawa Warehouse is used as the Otaru Gold Stone Live Theater, which rents its hall for various events.









Nikka Whisky Yoichi Distillery

The founder of Nikka Whisky, Masataka Taketsugu dedicated his whole life to making genuine whisky in Japan. This distillery offers a free 40-minute guided tour. where one can learn about this man's passion as well as the process of whisky making. After the tour there is also time for tasting.



Tan-Tetsu-Ko (Coal, Steel, Railways, and Ports) (Japan Heritage)

Following the development of coal mines in the Sorachi region, a railway was built between Horonai (part of the present-day Mikasa City) and Otaru in 1882 to transport the coal. The railway was later extended to Muroran, which led to a flourishing steelmaking industry. In this way, coal mines in the Sorachi region, ironworks and steel mills in Muroran, and the port of Otaru laid the foundation for industrial modernization (known as Tan-Tetsu-Ko (Coal, Steel, Railways, and Ports) on the Japan Heritage List). You can learn about the story of Tan-Tetsu-Ko, which brought prosperity to Otaru, at the guide exhibition in the Otaru Museum and at the Former Temiya Railway Facilities and the Site of the Former Temiva Railway, among other places.

Wineries in Yoichi Town

Yoichi Town, a major fruit producer in Hokkaido, also has a thriving wine industry. Home to 11 wineries, Yoichi was designated the Northern Fruit Kingdom Yoichi Wine Special District based on Japan's Act on Special Districts for Structural Reform. A wine tourism project was launched in Yoichi together with the neighboring town of Niki with the aim of establishing a major wine producing area in these towns and their environs.
